It's been many years since the Cadets from Explorer Post #721 have hosted an Explorer competition but 2009 brings a change to that! We have organized Capital Challenge 2009 with hopes of establishing a tradition that will become an annual event.

Capital Challenge is designed to be very demanding on the physical and mental capabilities of each Explorer.

Events will test the strengths and limitations of a person's intelligence, personality, demeanor, and physical abilities, as well as dedication and conviction to the Explorer Program.

Explorers will be given the opportunity to test their skills in real life situations including Felony Traffic Stops, DUI Stops, Vehicle Searches, Building Searches, and a Domestic Violence situation, just to name a few. Most events will be held in daylight with a few night time scenarios. Explorers will also get the chance to demonstrate their abilities in an adility test and a written exam.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each event. A Challenge Champions Trophy will be awarded to the Post with the highest overall scores based upon all events.

When a Post has multiple team entries in each event, the highest of those team scores will be used for the Challenge Champions scoring.

Posts are encouraged to fully participate since they will receive additional points for additional team entries in each event.
