MOTORIST SERVICE AIDE

PURPOSE:

To assist stranded motorists, to assist officers involved with traffic

control, accident scenes, and specified parking violations

DESCRIPTION:

Volunteer will use a marked vehicle which is supplied with cones, jumper cables, slim jim, flares, gas can, etc...in order to respond to stranded motorists or scenes where flares or cones might be needed. Volunteer will also issue citations for handicapped/fire lane parking violations. Volunteer will be issued and is responsible

for necessary uniform and equipment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Be at least 20 years of age Able to pass polygraph

Possess valid Arizona driver's license

Know basic automobile workings, including minimal mechanical

Able to change tires, use slim jims, and do heavy lifting

Able to interact effectively with public

Able to follow directions and work independently

Possess good decision making skills

Communicate effectively and clearly on the radio

Slim jim/equipment training

Four hours radio training; three-hour classroom session

Minimum 16 hours of On-the-road training with Motorist Service
